

Mary Immaculate School Advisory Board
Minutes
August 13, 2008

The meeting opened with prayers and reflections.

The 2008-2009 School Advisory Board notebooks were distributed and reviewed.

The Principal reported approximately 74 students are enrolled - 58 are Catholic and 16 are non-Catholic. All full-time teachers except for Rachel Zivney are returning. The Spanish classes will be taught by Ginger Nolker. Truman students will teach PE and Dr. Elaine Boda will continue to teach music classes.

The President reported that thank you notes were sent to all teachers who returned their contracts. An exit survey with feedback was reviewed. The intent is to continue to mail exit surveys to all families and teachers who have left Mary Immaculate encouraging them to return their responses to the President anonymously. Allison Pfeiffer's basketball jersey has been retired and plans have been made to display it with her basketball photo in the gym as a memorial.

The Principal requested feedback about the possibility of performing a self-study of the school this year (one year early). Discussion followed about the cost, timeline, and need for parent and parish involvement in the committees. It was determined from the discussion that we would proceed with the self-study this fall.
